Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

wir freuen uns sehr, Ihnen hiermit die erste Ausgabe unseres Internet-Newsletter präsentieren zu können. Die Hanns Seidel Stiftung ist seit 1987 in Korea aktiv. Die Transformation der internationalen Ordnung und die Zukunft der koreanischen Halbinsel

Hintergrund

Die internationale Ordnung wandelt sich seit den Terrorattacken vom 11. September 2001 und dem Sieg der USA im Irak schnell. Der seit dem Beginn der Bush-Verwaltung sich abzeichnende Unilateralismus wurde nach dem 11. September 2001 ein Kennzeichen der Außenpolitik der USA und durch den Irak-Krieg noch bestärkt. Zusätzlich ist die traditionelle transatlantische Allianz durch den Irak-Krieg in eine tiefe Krise gekommen. Die sich wandelnde internationale Ordnung hat auch direkte Auswirkungen auf die Situation auf der koreanischen Halbinsel. Einige Experten halten den „Bagdad-Effekt“, basierend auf militärischer Macht, auch für eine Option auf der koreanischen Halbinsel. Neben dem Wandel der internationalen Rahmenbedingungen gibt es aber auch einen Wandel in Korea. Die neue Regierung unter Roh Moo-hyun verfolgt eine revidierte Form der „Sonnenschein-Politik“.

Das Seminar auf Jeju wird diese internationalen und nationalen Änderungen diskutieren und die Zukunft von Kooperation und Konflikt zwischen Nord- und Südkorea analysieren.

Studienseminar zur kommunalen Selbstverwaltung in Bayern mit dem Research Institute for Local Councils (RILC) im Juli 2003

Im Juli 2003 wird die Hanns Seidel Stiftung gemeinsam mit dem dem Research Institute for Local Councils (RILC) mit einer Gruppe von Zehn Bürgermeistern und Landräten aus allen Provinzen Südkoreas ein Studienseminar durchführen. Thema der Reise ist die kommunale und regionale Selbstverwaltung in Bayern. Dabei werden voraussichtlich die fränkischen Städte Bamberg, Bayreuth, Würzburg und Aschaffenburg sowie eine Reihe von Gemeinden besucht, aber auch die oberfränkische Bezirksregierung. Die Themenpalette reicht vom Föderalismus und kommunalen Finanzausgleich bis hin zum kommunalen Umweltschutz und der Rolle staatlicher und privater Organisationen in der kommunalen Sozialpolitik. Auch ein Treffen mit dem Vorsitzenden der deutsch-koreanischen Parlamentariergruppe und neuen Präsidenten der Deutsch-Koreanischen Gesellschaft, Hartmut Koschyk (MdB – CSU) ist vorgesehen.

Roundtable-Gespräch „Juristische Aspekte der deutschen Wiedervereinigung“ anlässlich des Besuchs von Staatsminister der Justiz Dr. Manfred Weiß in Korea, am 25. April 2003, im Hilton-Hotel

Das Roundtable-Gespräch ist von der Hanns Seidel Stiftung in Zusammenarbeit mit der International Constitutional Law Association – Korean Branch sowie der Konrad-Adenauer Stiftung, Büro Korea, durchgeführt worden. Teilnehmer des Roundtable-Gesprächs waren der Abgeordnete , Menschenrechts- sowie Verfassungsrechtsexperte der Grand National Party, Kim Chol Su, Doyen der koreanischen Verfassungsrechtslehre, sowie etwa fünfzehn wichtige Jura-Professoren aus Korea, darunter die amtierenden Vorsitzenden der International Constitutional Law Association – Korean Branch, der Korean Public Law Association sowie der Korean Association for International Law.

Zunächst stellte Staatsminister Dr. Weiß in einem Einführungsvortrag, der bei den Teilnehmern auf großes Interesse stieß, die juristischen Aspekte der Bewältigung der deutschen Einheit vor. Dabei wurden insbesondere die Aspekte ‚Erlangung der staatlichen Einheit, Eigentumsordnung sowie die strafrechtliche Bewältigung der Unrechtstaten in der ehemaligen DDR am Beispiel der Mauerschützenurteile‘ erörtert. In der anschließenden Frage- und Diskussionsrunde wurden diese Aspekte vertieft, aber auch z.B. die konkrete Form der Hilfestellung der bayerischen Justiz beim Aufbau der Justizverwaltung in den neuen Bundesländern dargestellt.

Changing International Order and Future of Korean Peninsula

Background

International political order is rapidly changing after the Terrorist Attack on September 11th and the lopsided victory of the U.S. in the Iraq war. The U.S. unilateralism that has begun after inauguration of the Bush administration became a definite and firm foreign policy of the US after 9.11, and is much more strengthened after the Iraq war. In addition, the traditional Atlantic alliance is in a crisis by the conflicts between US and Europe caused by the Iraq war. The changing international situations are directly influencing to the Korean Peninsula. Some international experts argue that ‘Bagdad Effect’ based on the UN military power revealed its effectiveness in the Korean Peninsula. In addition to the changing international trends, there are lots of changing situations in the Korean peninsula. North Korea declared possession of nuclear weapons. The new Roh Moo Hyun government of South Korea would like to revise so called ‘Sunshine Policy’. To cope with these changing international environments, Jeju seminar will discuss the salient features of new international order, and review critical issues of cooperation and conflicts of South-North Korea.

Study seminar on local autonomy in Bavaria in cooperation with the Research Institute for Local Councils (RILC) in July 2003

In July 2003 Hanns Seidel Stiftung and the Research Institute for Local Councils (RILC) will arrange a study seminar for a group of ten mayors and heads of counties from all provinces of South Korea. They will get a one-week in depth seminar on local autonomy in Bavaria. The seminar includes visits to the Franconian towns of Bamberg, Bayreuth, Würzburg and Aschaffenburg as well as a number of smaller cities, but also the Upper Franconian regional government. Topics are for example the German system of federalism, local fiscal relations and redistribution, local environmental protection and the role of public and private organisations in local social policy. Also, the group will meet with Rep. Hartmut Koschyk (CSU), chairman of the German-Korean Parliamentary group and new president of the German-Korean society.

The roundtable discussion has been organized by Hanns Seidel Foundation in co-operation with the International Constitutional Law Association – Korean Branch and Konrad Adenauer Foundation, Korea office. Among the participants were the Hon. Rep. , human right and constitutional law expert of the Grand National Party, Kim Chol Su, doyen of Korean constitutional law research, and fifteen leading professors of law in Korea, among them the presidents of the International Constitutional Law Association – Korean Branch, the Korean Public Law Association and the Korean Association for International Law.

In his highly informative introductory presentation State Minister Dr. Weiß discussed the judicial aspects of German unification. He focused on constitutional aspects (unification), property law and criminal law, especially the legal aspects of the killings for crossing the German-German border (Mauerschützen). In the Q-and-A-session, Dr. Weiß did not only clarify many aspects, but also explained the practical help of Bavarian justice authorities in the transformation process towards the rule of law and democracy in the former German Democratic Republic.

배경

제작년에 발생했던 9.11 테러와 미국의 이라크 전 승리 이후 국제질서는 급변하고 있다. 부시행정부 출범이후에 계속되어온 일방주의는 2001년 9.11 테러 이후에 미국외교의 특징으로 자리잡았으며, 이라크전쟁을 통해 이러한 경향은 더욱 강해졌다. 게다가 전통적인 유럽과 미국의 우호적인 연합관계는 이라크전쟁으로 인해 매우 어려운 상황으로 빠져들었다. 이렇듯 급변하는 국제질서는 한반도상황에도 직접적인 영향을 미치고 있다. 일단의 전문가들은 군사적 무력에 기초한 "바그다드 효과"가 한반도에 한반도에도 적용될 수 있다는 가능성을 배제하지 않고 있다. 국제환경의 변화와 더불어 한국 국내에서도 변화가 일어나고 있다. 새로 출범한 노무현 정부는 수정된 형태의 "햇볕정책"을 지향할 것임을 표명하였다. 제주도에서 열릴 예정인 아래 세미나는 국내외 상황변화에 대한 논의와 함께 향후 남북한 간의 협조 및 갈등요인을 분석하는 장이 될 것이다.
